<b>Questions about how our school operates:</b>	<b>Answers:</b>
What time does School start/ finish?	Start- 8.40am Finish- 3.05pm
What times are break-times and lunch time?	Break- 11.00-11.20am Lunch- 12.20-1pm
What sort of food is sold?	Variety of hot and cold, including sandwiches, pizza and pasta
Where do students go at lunch time?	There are a number of clubs including table tennis, and an outside area just for Year 7
What snacks can you buy?	You can buy snacks such as toast, popcorn and muffins
How much homework do you get?	Each subject will set one piece of homework per week
What happens if it isn't done?	You should speak to your teacher if you are unable to complete your homework.
Where can I do my homework in my free time?	There are a number of ICT rooms and the LCR to complete your homework at lunchtimes and after school
What happens if I get into trouble? What are the punishments?	We do have late detentions and faculty detentions
Who's the best person to talk to if I am having problems?	My Form Tutor My Head of Year
How am I rewarded for my work?	Certificates Assembly recognition

<b>Questions about the timetable and learning opportunities in School</b>	<b>Answer</b>
