NCS: what's it all about?

Designed for 15-17 year olds, NCS is an inclusive summer programme that helps teens get the skills, experience and self-belief they need to achieve their potential - and smash their future goals.

Founded on the principles of social cohesion, social engagement and social mobility, NCS aims to make a life-changing difference to young people and how they approach life after school (something that can be daunting for even the most confident teens).

By the time they're done, they'll have the confidence to speak to a room full of people without freezing up and will know a whole lot more about what they want from life after school. Phase 3: Do Good gives students the chance to deliver an impressive 'passion project' – something that's previously led to young people making a huge difference in their community, countrywide and even globally.

The Cost

With every life changing experience comes with a price. NCS costs £1,500 per young person; this includes staffing, activities, activity leaders, travel and food. However, this cost is being heavily subsidised by your government. All we ask is for a small contribution of £50 to secure your young persons place on the programme. At NCS we don't let any financial barriers restrict young people from taking part. If your young person is entitled to *Free School Meals* or is on *Pupil Premium* then that price can be reduced. Just speak to us about this when you're signing up.
