



Childwall Sports & Science Academy – Summer school report

At Childwall Sports & Science Academy we hosted our year 6-7 summer transition school from August 23rd – 27th August 2021, we decided to run a late summer school as our students have identified this as being the most impactful week for them to attend. Students who have attended a late summer school with us in the past have stated that the summer school benefited them getting back into a routine after the summer break. We host our summer school on site to help build students' self-esteem and confidence. Our staff facilitate all aspects of the summer school and this really helps our students to build strong positive relationships whilst also removing any anxieties they may have about starting secondary school. On the final day of summer school, we did invite some external agencies in to support our students with their learning and to provide them with an enriched curriculum offer.

As part of the summer school, we decided to create a strong clear link with our whole school priority of reading. As a result of the outstanding funding we received, we were able to support students with reading at home by providing them with a kindle. We also provided them with inspirational books to read during reading time in summer school. We followed the usual school day timings so students could familiarise themselves with the routines required for when they started school in September 2021.
